"Hope and Fear" in conjunction with this year's Advent theme:
The Hopes and Fears of All the Years. As we look at the paradoxes of Christmas (hope and fear, peace and distress, joy and sadness, love and hate), we come face to face with the reality of life. We don't just experience hope, peace, joy, and love at Christmas, even especially at Christmas. We also experience fear, distress, sadness, and hate. And, all those elements are also found in scripture within that first Christmas event, when Jesus Christ was born.

In relationship to hope and fear, I was reminded of the story of Joseph Ton, who was pastor of a church in Romania when it was still under communist control. He went to Oxford in England to study. He could have stayed in England,


but he chose to go back. As he was leaving, the Holy Spirit

impressed a verse of scripture on his heart that would be lived out in his own life—Matthew 10:16—"I send you as sheep in the midst of wolves." He knew he would be totally defenseless and without reasonable hope of success. He was afraid.

He went back. He preached the gospel. He gained strength from his fellow believers who were under persecution. He was arrested and interrogated many times—each event becoming more severe. They threatened to kill him if he didn't stop proclaiming Jesus. God gave him the words to say. "Sir, your supreme weapon is killing me. My supreme weapon is dying. My sermons are on tape all over the country. If you kill me, you will be sprinkling them with my blood. Whoever listens to them after that will be saying, 'I'd better listen. This man sealed it with his own blood.' They will speak ten times louder than before. So, go on and kill me. I win the supreme victory then."

Joseph Ton says, "I spent all those years living in fear of those in authority because I wanted to live. Now, I wanted to die, and they wouldn't oblige. For years I wanted to save my life, and I was losing it. Now that I wanted to lose it, I was winning it." Hope amidst fear.

The next three weeks of Advent we will look at Peace and Distress, Joy and Sadness, and Love and Hate. Our Advent season culminates with our annual Christmas Eve Service—"Carols and Candlelight"—which begins at 5:00 p.m. It is a special service with scripture, singing, special music, and the lighting of candles. Simple, and yet profound. The perfect way to celebrate the true meaning of Christmas with family and friends. I hope you have a wonderful Christmas and a Happy New Year as we look towards what God will do in our midst in 2026.
