If there is anything I enjoy more than preaching in pastoral ministry, it would have to be teaching. It's in my gene pool. My mom was an incredible teacher—she taught 4th grade for many years. The testimonies of former students continue to this day, calling her the best teacher they ever had. Her father (my grandfather) engaged in education all his adult life, as a teacher and a principal. He worked over 50 years and never missed a single day of work! They even named an

elementary school in McKinney after him. Quite an honor.

Teachers made a huge impact on my life. My speech/drama teacher in high school was also a part-time Baptist preacher. After feeling called to ministry, I was invited to preach my first sermon at his church when I was only in the 9th grade. He always was a huge encouragement to me and someone I knew believed in what I could become. My choir teacher was, and continues to this day to be, the greatest choral conductor I've ever seen, and we had a top-notch choir program. My senior year I was the student conductor. I'm not a music major and never had a college-level music course, and yet, I learned how to conduct a choir and have used the skill in church work and even have taught choral music in high school. I love to direct a choir—a passion given to me through this man's influence.

I could go on, but my main point is the importance of teachers in our lives. As kids, teachers, and other school workers return to classrooms, let's remember them in our prayers. Let's pray for safety. Let's pray for knowledge

and skills to be learned. Let's pray for good attitudes. But most of all, let's pray for those special connections and relationships that can be life changing.

At the end of the children's moment in the worship service on August 17th, I will be leading us in a special prayer for our schools—the children and any adults who work in education. This will be a special, concentrated prayer time, so parents, please make every effort to be here with your children that Sunday as they get ready to start a new, exciting year of learning!


